The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Dan Hawkins at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 17, 2024, in Room 548-S, Statehouse.

1. Chairperson Hawkins presented the minutes of the meeting of the Legislature Coordinating Council held on December 2, 2024, for consideration and approval. Senator Larry Alley moved that the minutes as presented be approved. Representative Blake Carpenter seconded the motion. The motion carried.
2. Chairperson Hawkins provided an update on the bill tracking service vendor proposals process. The members participated in a discussion of the proposals. Such discussion is available on the legislative website. Chairperson Hawkins indicated the need for a 50-state bill tracking service to be included in the service and to provide time for the vendors to include such a tracking service in the proposals and adjust the pricing component of proposals accordingly. Members of the council emphasized the importance of security with the implementation of any service. All vendors will be given notice that the LCC has not made a decision and that the council may be requesting additional information.
